<b>1. Sparkling Brut - Breathless, NV, North Coast</b> Wonderful yeasty notes on the nose, lead way to lovely flavors of pear and citrus. Methode Champenoise. Chardonnay, Pinot Blend.	2.25	9.00	45.00
<b>2. Trousseau Gris - 2012 Falcor, Russian River Valley</b> Notes of green melon, peach, and tropical fruit give way to a soft palate with minerality on the finish. This obscure varietal is only grown in one vineyard in California and Falcor is one of only a few wineries to use this fruit.	3.00	12.00	35.00
<b>3. Sauvignon Blanc – 2011 Cornerstone, Napa Valley</b> Vibrant and rich with zesty notes of lemon peel and grapefruit with balanced minerality. Clean, crisp finish.	3.25	13.75	39.00
<b>4. Rosé - 2012 Blackbird, Napa Valley</b> 38% Merlot, 36% Cabernet Sauvignon, and 26% Cabernet Franc make up this Bordeaux inspired Rose sourced from several premiere vineyards in Napa. Notes of bright strawberry lead to citrus and a refreshing minerality on the palate.	3.25	13.00	37.00
<b>5. Albariño - 2012 Bodegas "Galicia," Edna Valley</b> Pronounced pear and peach combine with a floral hint on the nose followed through by juicy apple on the palate and a creamy finish.	3.75	15.00	42.00
<b>6. Chardonnay - 2011 Lost Canyon, Russian River Valley</b> A beautiful single vineyard Chardonnay from the Ruxton Vineyard planted in 1977. This wine starts off with notes of lemon and creme brûlée leading to a buttery, oaky finish with hints of citrus. Less than 550 cases produced.	3.75	15.00	41.00
<b>7. Chardonnay – 2011 Shadowbrook, San Francisco Bay</b> Estate grown fruit. Tropical aromas of pineapple and kiwi. Well balanced notes of vanilla and oak.	4.25	17.00	46.00
<b>8. Riesling - 2010 Santa Barbara Winery, Santa Rita Hills</b> Ripe fruit aromas of apricots and notes of jasmine. Off-dry in style with initial sweetness on the palate, a nectar-like mouth feel, nice minerality, and a refreshing acidic finish.	2.75	11.00	32.00

<b>9. Pinot Noir – 2012 Rock Wall Winery, Sonoma</b> From the winemakers that founded Rosenblum, this easy drinking wine is full of ripe fruit notes of strawberry and raspberry with a touch of pepper and good minerality.	4.50	18.00	45.00
<b>10. Meritage - 2010 Medlock Ames, Bell Mountain Ranch, Alexander Valley</b> A sumptuous blend of Cabernet Sauvignon (75%), Merlot (20%), and Cab Franc (5%). Handcrafted and organically produced with aromas of black fruit, a hint of clove and spice, flavors of cherry and cocoa.	4.00	16.00	44.00
<b>11. Zinfandel – 2010 Rock Wall Winery, “Monte Rosso”, Sonoma</b> Elegant and rich with full flavors of Black fruit and currants with a slight spiced finish.	4.50	18.00	45.00
<b>12. Cabernet Franc – 2011 Rock Wall Winery, Napa Valley</b> Sourced from the Holbrook Mitchell vineyard, and redolent of freshly sliced jalapeno, white pepper and ripe cherry on the nose, followed by succulent flavors of blueberry, black tea and luscious fruit.	4.50	18.00	45.00
<b>13. Spanish Style Blend - 2009 Bodegas “Vaca Negra”, Paso Robles</b> Made up of 43% Mourvedre, 36% Tempranillo, and 21% Grenache this blend offers up a spicy nose with pronounced cedar and black fruit. The finish is dark and juicy, with a hint of coffee.	3.50	14.00	39.00
<b>14. Cabernet Sauvignon – 2010 Stepping Stone, Napa Valley</b> A gorgeously vibrant nose of red berry fruit, subtle spice with hints of dried herbs combine with a lush, silky, mouth watering palate with a smooth, subdued tannins.	4.25	17.00	47.00
<b>15. Red Blend – 2010, Shadowbrook, “Encore”, San Francisco Bay</b> Malbec, Petite Verdot and Petite Syrah combine to make this an aromatic gem. Full of black fruit flavors with a hint of anise and mocha with nice tannins. Winery is located here in Walnut Creek.	2.75	11.00	32.00
